\$165.00 (with \$50.00 add-back) – Novice –Intermediate
Dressage Tests: \$25.00 Beginner Novice – Intermediate Test B (Small Arena)
\$30.00 Intermediate C – FEI * - FEI **** (Standard Arena)
Stabling: \$100.00 (section 5)
Trailer-In Fee: \$ 30.00
Muck fee: \$ 15.00 (separate check) STALL MUST BE STRIPPED for return of muck fee.
Grounds fee: \$ 30.00 (non/competing horses)
Camping: \$ 50.00 RV, or primitive \$30.00(section 6)

1) ENTRIES: Entry fees include a \$25 non-refundable office fee, free shavings and competitors' party. Please state email address on entry. Divisions may be further divided or combined if entries warrant. *Please send entries together of those wanting to stable together, or specify same Trainer or same Barn name only.*

Entries Limited to Stall Capacity.

Multiple entries: Horse qualifies for prize money on first go, in first division competed in. Horse may go in other divisions with same rider or different rider for \$35.00 schooling fee. Rider may have multiple rides, horse may only win prize money once. Any entry changes after closing date = \$30. Changes allowed after Wednesday prior to competition only if schedule and entries permit. Neg. Coggins within 12 months required for all horses.

Refunds: Before C.D.-Less \$25 non-refundable office fee. **WITHDRAWALS MUST BE IN WRITING TO SEC'Y BEFORE C.D.; email withdrawal accepted with accompanying phone call.** After C.D.-No refund.

Competition cancellation-No refund.

2) TENTATIVE TIME SCHEDULE:

Sat: Dressage start times are determined by the number of entries. Ride times will be posted on website by Wednesday of the competition week and may start as early as 8 am. Dressage Tests are not counted for points towards prize money. Competitor Party (Wine & Cheese) 6 pm.

Sun: Jumping Derby start determined by number of entries. Ride times also posted on website by Wednesday of competition week: May start as early as 8 am.

3) AWARDS: \$5,000 prize money. Distribution of money is listed on entry form on web site:river-glen.com. Entry forms also available by calling the office at 865/475-1005.

4) STARTING TIMES: Will be posted on web at www.river-glen.com by Wednesday or call (865) 475-1005 Wednesday, week of event. Results will be posted on same site within 2 days of event.

5) STABLING/VETERINARIAN: Limited to stall capacity, \$100 for weekend. 210 perm. stalls on grounds. Sawdust bedding included in cost: Bag shavings available, \$6.

Veterinarian: on grounds through event. Emergency # will be posted at phones outside office.

All hotels are approx. 15 miles. **CAMPING:** Primitive, on grounds=\$30 for duration RV Hook up = \$50 for duration.

7) DIRECTIONS: Address: 1839 London Rd., New Market, TN 37820 **DO NOT FOLLOW MAPQUEST!!!**

From Knoxville and West (I-40): Exit 394: Turn LEFT at light at exit onto 11E. Travel East approx. 16 miles to RG sign on left of hwy (Lowery Loop Rd). On right is New Market Church. Turn left and go straight at stop sign. At Baker Rd. turn left (signs will direct you from there). Approx. 5 miles.

(NOTE: Do NOT take fork to the right on 11E that says 11W/25W)

From Dandridge and East (I-40): Exit 417: Turn RIGHT at light at exit, onto Hwy 92. Travel North approx 10 mi. to 11E. Turn left (West) for approx 6 mi to RG sign on right at Lowery Loop Rd. Follow directions as above. More complete directions from hotels on website: river-glen.com

8) DRESSAGE: Dressage Tests are optional and do not count for Jumping Derby points or prize money. Tests are by choice of competitor and are designated on entry form. Dressage Tests are USEF Eventing Dressage Tests, Beginner Novice – Intermediate, FEI* - FEI****.

9) Jumping Course: **Intermediate** – approx 1415m@500m/m. **Preliminary** – approx 1200m@450 m/m. **Training** – approx. 1000m @ 450 m/m. **Novice** – approx. 900m @ 400 m/m. **Beginner Novice** – approx. 900m @ 350m/m.

Riders should arrive early enough to walk their courses. Once the jumping phase has begun, course walks will only be allowed during breaks between divisions. See web site for sample course maps: www.river-glen.com.
